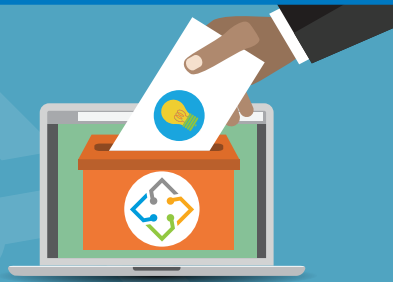


2023-2025 CORPORATE PLAN SUBMISSIONS
