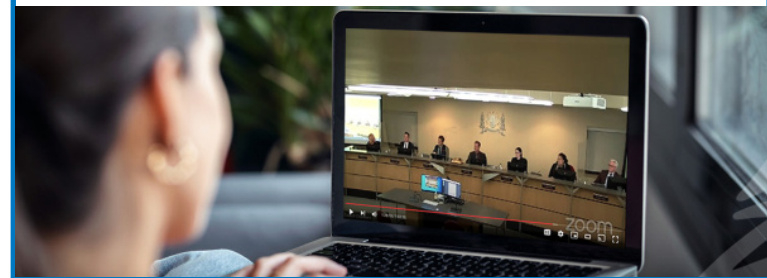
## Regular Council meeting

## Upcoming signal change at intersection to support traffic safety

To support traffic safety, a signal change is being implemented that will affect drivers making left-hand turns at the intersection of Highway 16A and Jennifer Heil Way.

Effective September 12, for drivers making a left-hand turn, there will be an advance arrow that will then turn a red light. This means drivers will only be able to turn left at this intersection during the advance arrow.

This signal change has been recommended by Spruce Grove Enforcement Services, the City's Community Road Safety Advisory Committee, and a review by a third-party, and will help improve traffic safety at this intersection.

Signs indicating the signal change will also be installed to inform drivers as they approach the intersection.
