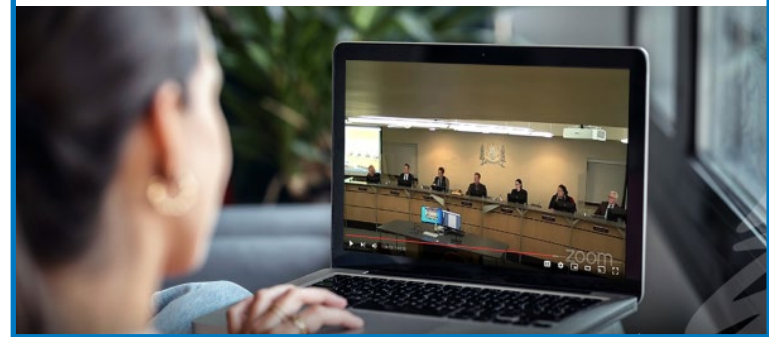
Regular Council meeting

Whether we walk, ride a bike, hop on a skateboard or get behind the wheel of a car, we all have a role to play in crosswalk safety.

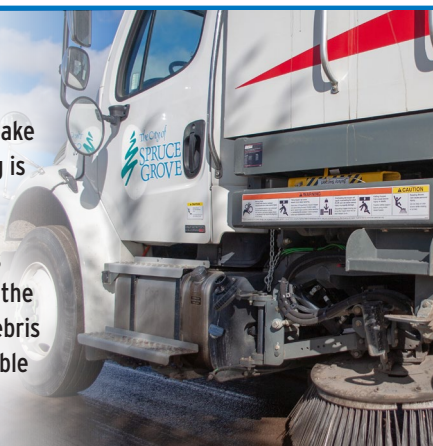
