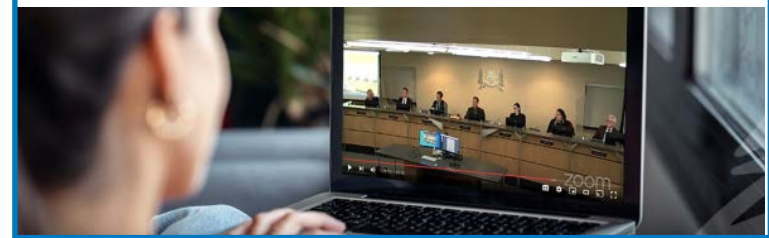


## Committee of the Whole meeting
