

## Changes to extra organics collection

Starting next month, changes are coming to how residents will be able to dispose of extra organics waste.

Effective April 1, 2023, additional organics waste can be brought to the Eco Centre at no charge, up to three cubic metres or saved for next week's pickup. Curbside or alley collection of extra organic waste will no longer be available in order to minimize the impacts to solid waste collection rates.
