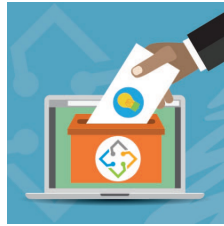


Corporate Plan Submissions

Upcoming work on Highways 16A and 16; July 3 – July 22

Starting on or about July 3, overnight resurfacing work will be occurring on Highway 16A eastbound from Jennifer Heil Way to Nelson Drive and from Century Road to the east City limit. This work will be completed overnight to minimize traffic disruptions and traffic will be accommodated in the westbound lanes. This work is expected to take approximately three weeks.
