Community Social Development temporarily relocating to 410 King Street, effective Dec. 4

The City of Spruce Grove's Community Social Development Department (CSD) is temporarily relocating to 410 King Street while work is being completed on its new permanent home, which will be at 414 King Street.

CSD's last day operating at its current location (105 - 505 Queen Street) will be Thursday, November 30. It will re-open at 410 King Street to walk-in traffic and those with general inquiries on Monday, December 4 and hours will remain 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1 to 4 p.m.

The department will move to its permanent home at 414 King Street in the new year. Dates and details will be shared once confirmed.



Domestic Violence Community Grant

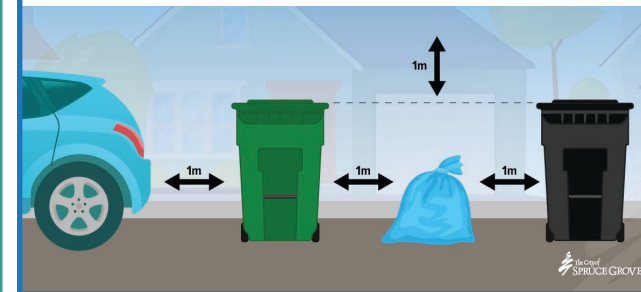

Learn about waste collection requirements and new cart storage guidelines

When putting your black waste cart and green organics cart out for collection, please remember to keep these guidelines in mind to help ensure efficient pickup:

- Carts must be set out for collection by 7 a.m. on your collection day, but no earlier than 24 hours in advance of your collection day.
- Remember to space your waste. Ensure there is at least one meter's length of clearance on all sides of the carts.
- New! When it's not collection day, all your carts must be stored on your personal property. That means no carts on the road, sidewalk, or alley.

New waste collection option for properties with secondary suites

Properties with secondary suites will now have the option to opt-in to solid waste service for the secondary suite under the residence's primary utility account. The monthly solid waste utility fee for secondary suites will be added to an existing service account in the name of the owner of the primary account.
