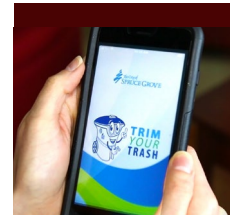
### Sort with Success

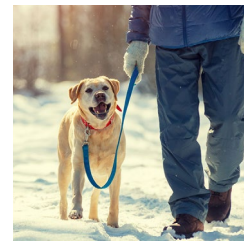

### Regular Council meeting

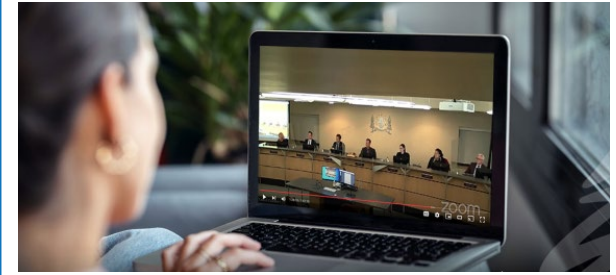
#### Monday, February 26, 2024
